

California Grand Assembly – Dress Code

GENERAL APPEARANCE

- Proper undergarments must always be worn and not visible
- Body piercing jewelry should not be worn at Rainbow functions. Earrings should be worn in the earlobes
- Clothes should be clean and neat in appearance
- Always “Dress for Success”; keeping in mind that the attire should be AGE and EVENT appropriate
- Be sure that shirts are long enough that there are no bare midribs when arms are raised
- If nylons are not used, “Peds” of some kind are required

Shrugs are acceptable No halter straps No tank tops under formals</p> <p><u>Back</u> No lower than natural bra line.</p> <p><u>Slits</u> Not to exceed your knee</p> <p><u>Socks</u> Nylons, Knee Highs or Peds</p> <p><u>Shoes</u> Dress shoes (white or pastel, no higher than 1", sandals are not considered dress shoes.)</p> <p>Men Dress pants, dress shirt & tie (jacket optional)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Ladies/Girls</p> <p><u>Dress/Skirt</u></p> <p><u>Length</u> Must not be more than two inches above the knee</p> <p><u>Color</u> Any color (Black or navy skirt is acceptable)</p> <p><u>Pants</u> Dress pants (at natural waist line, black or navy is acceptable)</p> <p><u>Blouses</u> Dress blouses or sweater Not too short or too tight</p> <p><u>Socks</u> Nylons, Knee Highs or Peds</p> <p><u>Shoes</u> Dress Shoes (color appropriate to skirt or pants color, no higher than 1", sandals are not considered dress shoes)</p> <p>Men Dress pants & dress shirt or polo shirt</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Ladies/Girls</p> <p><u>Dress/Skirts/Skorts</u></p> <p><u>Length</u> Must not be more than two inches above the knee</p> <p><u>Pants/Jeans</u> Worn at waistline, hemmed, no holes</p> <p><u>Shorts</u> Not above mid-thigh, hemmed (No cut offs), no holes</p> <p><u>Shirts/Polos/T-Shirts</u> Shirts must contain no print that is offensive or controversial. Matching Assembly Polos or T-Shirts are appropriate</p> <p><u>Shoes</u> Casual (No flip flops)</p> <p>Men Casual pants and shirts are acceptable and should follow the same guidelines as stated above</p>
<p>No T-shirts with long skirts allowed. Never any halter straps or revealing formals/dresses - No cleavage showing when standing or bending over.</p>	<p>No T-shirts with long skirts allowed. No jeans, hip huggers, tight pants, skorts, miniskirts, capris, T-Shirts, tube tops, halter tops, clogs, flip flops or athletic shoes.</p>	<p>No hip huggers, cutoff/short shorts, tight pants, miniskirts, tube tops, halter tops, spandex shorts/pants, or flip-flops</p>

- A ballot vote will be taken, by the girls of the Assembly, to determine the choice of dress code as outlined above.
