



## Reopening Guidance and Rules for California IORG Assemblies (Effective March 16, 2022)

The following safety strategies will be followed using the current guidance and recommendations of CDPH:

- **Face Coverings**
  - Masks are optional for all girls and adults, but remain strongly recommended.
  - Masks are not required indoors or outdoors.
- **Protocols**
  - Girls/Adults who test positive for COVID-19 will follow CDPH Isolation recommendations.
  - Testing is recommended for girls/adults with multiple symptoms aligned with COVID-19.
  - For further isolation and quarantine guidance, please review [CDPH's latest recommendations](#).
- **Social Distancing**
  - Social Distancing is no longer required
    - Hugging and holding hands is acceptable (including Rainbow Prayer and Rainbow Dreams).
- **Food**
  - Pre-packaged food is not necessary.
  - Food gatherings are welcomed following safe practices.
  - There will be no social distancing requirements while eating indoors or outdoors.
- **Mega-event Limitations**
  - See [CDPH Guidance](#) for the following:
    - Indoor events with 1,000 or more people
- **Grand Assembly**
  - Understanding different comfort levels throughout the organization as regulations are rolled back, we are recommending wrist bands based on personal preference.
    - Green- High Fives, Hand Shakes and Hugs
    - Yellow- Elbows Only (Still Cautious)
    - Red or Orange- Waving hello while social distancing (Highly Cautious)
  - Additionally, if Grand Assembly has more than 1,000 attendees we will have to follow the State "Mega Event" guidelines which includes obtaining vaccination information or negative tests prior to entry.

California Rainbow has prioritized safety throughout the pandemic, closely following CDPH, for guidance on management of COVID-19 within our organization. We will continue to monitor the State guidelines to make sure we are the most up to date on ways to limit the impact of COVID-19 throughout our organization.
