GENERAL APPEARANCE

- Proper undergarments must always be worn and not visible
- Body piercing jewelry should not be worn at Rainbow functions. Earrings should be worn in the earlobes
- Clothes should be clean and neat in appearance
- Always "Dress for Success"; keeping in mind that the attire should be AGE and EVENT appropriate
- Be sure that shirts are long enough that there are no bare midriffs when arms are raised
- If nylons are not used, "Peds" of some kind are required
