

DRESS CODE

- This event is going to follow the casual dress code, which can be found on the gocarainbow.org website.
- Comfortable shoes are a must!
- You might want to bring a jacket if you plan on staying late into the night.
- You will be given a Disneyland Leadership shirt that you <u>MUST</u> wear while in the park.
- Disney ears and hats are encouraged!

HELPFUL REMINDERS



DISNEYLAND PARKING:

There are multiple places to park at the Disneyland Park, Mickey and Friends is the most convenient and opens at 7am. It costs \$30 to park at all of the parking locations on site. Remember to make sure that all of your drivers have their money.

MEALS:

Make sure your assembly has a plan for all meals during the day (depending on how long you plan to be in the park). We suggest getting breakfast prior to arriving at the park on Saturday. There are also lockers available inside and outside the park for a fee if your group opts to bring any food for meals or to store larger items during the day.

INSIDE THE PARK:

It is <u>your responsibility</u> to keep track of your girls throughout the day. Disney may be crowded; we will not be the only people there. If your girls are younger, you might consider having them stay with you throughout the day. If your girls are older and you feel comfortable with them being without an adult, we suggest setting up a system where you periodically check-in with them. It is important that girls are in groups of at least two.

EMERGENCY:

In the event of a life threatening emergency, please call 911 before contacting the Leadership Team.



HELPFUL REMINDERS



TICKETS:

Once you receive your ticket into the park, make sure to keep it in a safe place. Your ticket allows you to enter, exit, and reenter the park. You will only receive one throughout the day.

DISNEYLAND APP:

Downloading the Disneyland App is recommended to make your day in the park as enjoyable as possible. The Disneyland App can be used as a map to the park, view ride wait times, and most importantly, you can load your ticket onto the app and use that for entry and reentry into the park should you lose your paper ticket.

IN PARK ACTIVITY

On the day of the event you and your group will be given the opportunity to participate in an in-park activity. Pick your favorite location in the park and create a video highlighting one of our <u>CA IORG fundamentals from the Strategic Plan</u>. The best submissions will receive a shoutout!

QR CODE STICKERS
